

Mayor Connie Schroeder

Schroeder is an honors graduate of the University of Texas at Austin and holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Civil Engineering. She became a licensed Professional Engineer in 1988. During her career she was a project engineer for a land development civil design firm, a project manager and estimator for a heavy construction company, project manager for a developer and served as the Road and Bridge Maintenance Engineer for Travis County. In 1994 she joined Motorola where she held a number of management positions until she retired in 2009.

After retiring, Schroeder volunteered for CASA as an advocate and served on their Board of Directors as an officer. She volunteered for the YMCA and was appointed to the City of Bastrop's Planning and Zoning Commission in 2011 and served until she entered the political arena in January 2017. Schroeder was elected the first female Mayor of the City of Bastrop in May of 2017. She has earned TML's Certified Municipal Official designation in both 2018 and 2019 and currently sits on the TML Board representing Region 10.
